4. Issued advisory for novel Corona Virus (2019-nCoV) on $21^{\text {st }}$ January, 2020.
5. Revised advisory for $2019-\mathrm{nCoV}$ issued on $25^{\text {th }}$ Januray,2020.
6. Established close liaison with relevant stakeholders like provincial health departments, WHO, Directorate of Central Health Establishment, NDMS and other relevant stakeholders.
7. Provided personal protective equipment (PPE), and viral transport medium (VTM) to Directorate of Central Health Establishment.
8. NIH has notified two Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) to tackle any emergency situation.
9. NIH has facilitated in the activation of thermal scanners at all international airports
