- One case confirmed from GB, bringing the total to 20.
- Number of calls to passengers returning from Italy: 71

**NIH Preparedness and Response:**

- BSL-3 mobile lab is ready for testing.
- IPC trainings and hospital assessment have started in Skardu.
- Training of the GB lab staff has been conducted at NIH and necessary equipment provided.
- IPC training is in progress for Railway General Hospital, Rawalpindi

**Provinces Preparedness and Response**

<b>Balochistan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 432 newly arrived individuals screened and quarantined at Taftan border in last 24 hours.</li> <li>• The contacts of first confirmed case contacted for detail investigation.</li> </ul>
<b>Sindh</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 suspected cases investigated from Hyderabad. All found negative.</li> </ul>
<b>Punjab</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Quarantine facility established at University Campus, DG Khan.</li> </ul>
<b>KP &amp; TD</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 01 alert generated (self-referral) in Police and Services Hospital, Peshawar. Case declared healthy after investigation.</li> <li>• Training and capacity building of healthcare providers and supporting staff provided.</li> </ul>
<b>GB</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Screening points: Gilgit, Skardu airport, Juglote district, Stak district, district Ghanche, district Diamer, district Hunza</li> </ul>

**Risk Communication:**

1. Clean your hands regularly with an alcohol-based hand rub, or wash them with soap.
2. Clean surfaces regularly with recommended disinfectants (70% Ethyl Alcohol or 0.5% bleach solution).
3. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with contaminated hands.
4. Practice respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow or tissue and then immediately dispose off.
5. Wear a medical/surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms and perform hand hygiene after disposing off of the mask.
6. Maintain a minimum of mandatory one meter distance from individuals with respiratory symptoms.
7. Healthcare workers are required to select and use appropriate PPE.
8. **Administrative controls** include ensuring the availability of IPC resources such as appropriate infrastructure, clear IPC policies, access to lab testing, triage and patient placement, adequate staff and training of staff.
9. **Environmental and engineering controls** aim at reducing the spread of pathogens and reducing the contamination of surfaces and inanimate objects.
