Risk Communication:

- 1. Clean your hands regularly with an alcohol-based hand rub, or wash them with soap.
- 2. Clean surfaces regularly with recommended disinfectants (70% Ethyl Alcohol or 0.5% bleach solution).
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with contaminated hands.
- Practice respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow or tissue and then immediately dispose off. 4.
- Wear a medical/surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms and perform hand hygiene after disposing off of the mask.
- Maintain a minimum of mandatory one meter distance from individuals with respiratory symptoms. 6.
- Healthcare workers are required to select and use appropriate PPE.
- Administrative controls include ensuring the availability of IPC resources such as appropriate infrastructure, clear IPC policies, access to lab testing, triage and patient placement, adequate staff and training of staff.
- Environmental and engineering controls aim at reducing the spread of pathogens and reducing the contamination of surfaces and inanimate objects.
