Sindh Educational institutes closed till 31st May, 2020. • **Punjab** • Health Emergency declared. KP & TD A total of 75 personnel including doctors, paramedics and sanitary staff were trained on IPC and clinical management of COVID-19 at KTH, Peshawar and Mardan. One new suspected case reported from DHO, Abbotabad. AJK Quarantine facilities have been established in College of Medical Technology (CMT) Hostel Mirpur, Chinese Camp at Khunbanwy and Block D in District Complex Rawalakot. Isolation rooms/wards have been established in AIMS, SKBZ Hospital/CMH Muzaffarabad and Rawalakot.

## **Risk Communication:**

GB

1. Clean your hands regularly with an alcohol-based hand rub, or wash them with soap.

Briefing of politician and bar council members.

- 2. Clean surfaces regularly with recommended disinfectants (70% Ethyl Alcohol or 0.5% bleach solution).
- **3.** Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with contaminated hands.
- 4. Practice respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow or tissue and then immediately dispose off.
- 5. Wear a medical/surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms and perform hand hygiene after disposing off of the mask.
- **6.** Maintain a minimum of mandatory one meter distance from individuals with respiratory symptoms.
- 7. Healthcare workers are required to select and use appropriate PPE.
- **8. Administrative controls** include ensuring the availability of IPC resources such as appropriate infrastructure, clear IPC policies, access to lab testing, triage and patient placement, adequate staff and training of staff.
- 9. Environmental and engineering controls aim at reducing the spread of pathogens and reducing the contamination of surfaces and inanimate objects.
