Risk Communication:											
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Clean your hands regularly with an alcohol-based hand rub, or wash them with soap. Clean surfaces regularly with recommended disinfectants (70% Ethyl Alcohol or 0.5% bleach solution). Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with contaminated hands. Practice respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow or tissue and then immediately dispose off. Wear a medical/surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms and perform hand hygiene after disposing off of the mask. Maintain a minimum of mandatory one meter distance from individuals with respiratory symptoms. Healthcare workers are required to select and use appropriate PPE. Administrative controls include ensuring the availability of IPC resources such as appropriate infrastructure, clear IPC policies, access to lab testing, triage and patient placement, adequate staff and training of staff. Environmental and engineering controls aim at reducing the spread of pathogens and reducing the contamination of surfaces and inanimate objects.
