Independence Day Celebrations Programme, 14th August 2021

Objective

To provide health guidelines for prevention of transmission of COVID-19 during Independence Day celebrations and related events.

Rationale

COVID-19 pandemic continues with emergence of variants of concern which cause rapid human-tohuman transmission. Independence Day of Pakistan is celebrated every year on 14th August. The events conducted in relation to Independence Day celebrations during Covid-19 pandemic can amplify the transmission of the virus and potentially disrupt the country's response capacity. Preventive measures play an important role in limiting the spread of a disease and can help in reducing the infection transmission and unnecessary burden on health care facilities.

Preparations-Administrative and Logistics

- Mapping of all event areas by district and provincial administration in line with COVID protocols
- Media campaign for awareness of masses.
- Strict enforcement of SOPs by civil administration.

Maintaining Healthy Environments

Implement strategies to maintain healthy environments during independent day celebrations program/event

- Ensure vaccination of leaders and attendees (administration of at least one dose is mandatory)
- Hand sanitizers should be made available at the entry and exit points of the events/gathering.
- Encourage attendees ahead of the event to bring and use masks at the event.
- Ensure that: -masks are available at the venue -worn appropriately, to cover nose and mouth at all times during the event
- All common-touch surfaces must be frequently cleaned and sanitized with recommended disinfectants (alcohol or chlorine-based).



- Washrooms must be cleaned frequently and sanitized
- Ensure that shared equipment (e.g., microphones) are cleaned/disinfected frequently and after each use. Consider pre-recorded speeches.
- Ensure adequate ventilation
- Limit attendance and seating capacity to allow for social distancing. Encourage people to stay at least 6 feet apart by providing signs or other visual cues such as tape or chalk marks.
- Where possible, use multiple entrances and exits; ensure that waiting areas are not crowded.
- Prioritize outdoor activities where social distancing can be maintained as much as possible.
- Broadcast announcements on reducing the spread of COVID-19 on public address systems.

Flag Hoisting Ceremonies

- The flag-hoisting ceremony should be restricted to Government officials in their designated areas, outdoors.
- Thermal scanning of all the participants attending the event may be carried out
- The participants should strictly follow the healthy behaviors to prevent the spread of disease.
 - Practice social distancing and maintain 6 feet distance
 - All attendees should use face masks appropriately to cover nose and mouth
 - The rope of the flag and other frequently touched surfaces should be sanitized
 - The government official hoisting the flag should wear gloves and immediately discard them after hoisting

Note: The above recommendations are being regularly reviewed by the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination and will be updated based on the international & national recommendations and best practices.
